Jordan Lewis Missions (JLM) has been established to honor the life and legacy of Jordan A. Lewis, a graduate of Oral Roberts University, who fought a valiant battle against cancer and joined his Creator at the age of 23. Jordan's unflinching, unyielding faith in Christ was apparent to all whom he came in contact with. He served the Lord pure heartedly, modeling Christ in all that he did.

While at university, Jordan went with a team to Tanzania and planted a church in a previously unreached tribe. Jordan was the first person to plant a seed, the forerunner, the person who broke ground, and in honor of Jordan's legacy, JLM works to bring the Gospel to the unreached people groups of the world. With nearly

2 billion people yet to hear about Jesus, we partner with people and projects which are strategically and measurably productive in this endeavor.

Over the past year, JLM has seen massive surges in fruitful Gospel activities. In some cases we are not even able to share details because the activities occur in closed access nations where evangelism is strictly prohibited and punishable by death or imprisonment. JLM projects span the globe and include China, North Korea, the Middle East and more.

 87%

Money that goes toward the Reached world:  
\$609 billion

*That means 87% of the money given to any Christian cause [1] goes to areas with "reached" status or access to the gospel already. [2]*



 1%

Money that goes toward Unreached Peoples:  
\$450 million\*

*That's only 1% of what is given to Christian causes. [2] That's also how much Americans in 2011 spent on Halloween costumes (for their pets).*
